Round I Re-admission 2019-2020

Lap-Chee College aims to promote whole-person development by providing a free, intellectual, cultural and social environment for students. It is believed that a 1:1:1 ratio between local, mainland and overseas students, as well as a 1:1 ratio between undergraduate and post-graduate students could be one of the approaches in fulfilling these aims.

The re-admission criteria, re-admission process and appeal process are described as follows.

1. Re-admission Criteria

The re-admission criteria could be divided into two categories, need-based and merit-based.

Re-admission criteria: Merit-based

Our college considers the student achievements as one of the merit-based re-admission criteria. These include, but not limited to, academic achievements, extracurricular achievements, community engagement and commitments to the mission and vision of our college. Moreover, the track records of participation in college activities provided and good citizenship in the college will also be measured.

Re-admission criteria: Need-based

In addition to the merit-based criteria, our college will also consider the applicants who are in the following conditions:

- Adverse home environment
- Distance and time traveled between campus and home

The need-based re-admission criteria shall be considered on a case-by-case basis subject to the proof provided by the candidate.

2. Re-admission Process

Applicants **MUST** complete **(1) the internal application form from Monday 18th March 2019 at 10:00 a.m. to Friday, 29th March 2019 at 11:59 p.m. (GMT+8)** AND **(2) Round I Admission 2019-2020 online application form (apply via HKU Portal)** later on. Shortlisted applicants will then be invited for interviews to be conducted by the Master and/or the Deputy Master and Tutors.



Internal Application Form

Applicants should complete the application form and a personal statement in **English** of not more than 100 words. Applicants are encouraged to describe their academic and extracurricular achievements, community engagement, utilization of college activities and facilities, commitments that can be beneficial to the progressive development of our college, the living experience in the college and/or any other relevant items.

Interview

Applicants will be invited for interview by the Master, Deputy Master and/or Tutors after the submission of internal application form and personal statement. **Applicants will be required to attend the interviews on the date, time and at the venue specified on their invitation emails.** Should there be any scheduling conflicts, High Table Dinner rules will apply, i.e., valid proof of absence must be sent to the Lap-Chee College email and the applicant's floor tutor. The re-admission decision will be made by the Master and/or Deputy Master and the tutors-in-charge.

Appeal Process

Unsuccessful applicants may submit appeal in the Round I Admission System via HKU Portal within 72 hours immediately following the announcement of results. **Appellants must clearly state in the appeal applications, the grounds for the appeals, provide proofs of evident if they think the initial decisions of the admission panel did not accurately represent their achievements and/or may provide new/ additional information to buttress the point(s) of the appeals.** The appeal panel will be chaired by the Master or Deputy Master together with the tutors not involved in the re-admission exercise. **Appellants who do not receive any response(s) of their appeal result(s) should deem that, the initial decision(s) of the admission panel is/ are upheld.**
